Information for Bidders

Ferrari 250MM Motor, No. 0276MM - Garage find in Italy!



An ultra-rare "garage-find" engine in Italy of an extremely rare and authentic Ferrari racing engine from 1953. Discovered after 40 years in storage in the back of a machine shop in Emilia-Romagna, it was recommissioned by that shop. It is engine number 0276MM that is rebuilt, run-in, and dynoed in Italy in April 2022.

This 1970 Maserati Indy 4.2L (VIN AM116414) is an impressive and stylish GT car and is presented in excellent condition. The Indy was 2+2 variant of the Ghibli and entered production in 1969 using the same running gear as the Ghibli. Only 1,136 Indys were made during its six-year run and this is #414. The original purchaser of the car was the infamous "Baby Doc" Duvalier, the president of Haiti from 1971 to 1986.

Dr. Cuny has owned the car for nearly 40 years and has more than \$60,000 in receipts for restoration work completed during his ownership. (Documentation is available upon request.)

Gianpiero Moretti is a legend. As a young man, he started racing and designed his own steering wheel for better performance which was the beginning of MOMO steering wheels. Moretti went on to continue racing and finally got his big win with an overall victory at the 1998 Daytona 24 Hours in a Ferrari 333SP.

On offer is one of Moretti's race-worn suits that he reportedly wore during the 1998 Daytona race, so it is a piece of history. The suit was made by MOMO, and also features its distinctive livery. The suit is tastefully mounted in a display case.

Rare! Borrani Race Wheel from Briggs Cunningham's 1962 Maserati Tipo 151



One of the stars of this auction! On offer is Borrani Record-RW3749 which was originally mounted to the early 60s Maserati contender at Le Mans, the #3 1962 Tipo 151/1 driven by Briggs Cunningham. Records do not show precisely which Tipo 151/1 had this wheel, but the three cars entered at the 1962 Le Mans had devastatingly quick speeds, believed to be the first car to top 300 kph!

This wheel is 6.5"x16" rear wheel with a 42RLsp hub and 72 spokes. The wheel has been powder coated and is in pristine condition. A rare and unique opportunity to own a piece of Maserati history!




